Chronic Anemia in Haiti a Major Health Concern



Lack of adequate food and access to health care makes Haitians, especially those of childbearing year, mothers, and children at risk for chronic anemia.

Although insecurity in Haiti has kept homeopaths from travelling to provide community clinics, they are providing care in their immediate neighborhoods.

In a recent clinic, Phadael Gregory Fallens, MD, treated a young woman with anemia so severe that she stated, "I thought I was going to die."
