Dear Dee,

We write to you with a profound sense of urgency and a shared commitment to extend a lifeline to the people of Haiti during this time of need. As you may be aware, Haiti is currently facing unprecedented challenges, with the recent resignation of its prime minister and the escalating presence of gang violence exacerbating an already dire humanitarian crisis.

The warring gangs are reported to be in control of 80% of the capital city Port-au-Prince. Thousands of people of all ages have been driven from their homes and are living in crowded conditions in several sites in the city. It is dangerous to leave the sites even to acquire food.

Amidst this chaos, the basic needs of Haitian citizens - access to food, healthcare, clean water, sanitation facilities, and psychological support - have reached a critical juncture, demanding immediate intervention.

In response to this urgent call for assistance, Homeopaths Without Borders, in collaboration with the Association Des Homéopathes Haïtiens (AHH) launched the "Lifeline for Haiti" project—an initiative aimed at providing vital healthcare services to the most vulnerable populations in Haiti.

Crucial assistance is needed now at displacement camps – where families are in desperate need of medical attention and support. The Lifeline for Haiti project will serve more than 12,000 individuals in Haiti over a three-month period. **Our goal is to raise \$21,000 for this project to HELP SAVE LIVES.**
